
Venography picture shows a fully blocked Left Iliac vein in the groin



A wire is used to cross the blockage and balloon is used to dilate (expand) the blockage and create a passage for the blood



Following the balloon dilatation, a channel is now created in the previously blocked left lliac vein



A Metallic Stent is now placed across the blockage, and opened up, to fully expand the vein





The stent is then expanded by a balloon, so the stent is now fully opposed to the vein wall
